 Hewlet Sullivan of the State aforesaid & Dist of Greenville have bargained
 & sold & released and by these presents do grant bargain
 sell & release unto the s^d Hewlet Sullivan all that plantation
 or tract of Land containing Two Hundred Acres more or less
 situate in the Dist of Greenville & State aforesaid lying on the banks
 of Reedy River. Beginning on a Red Oak 3x thence N14 W16 to a
 Stake 3x thence S75 W13 to a Hickory 3x thence S30 E 25 to a Stake 3x
 thence S60 W130 to Hickory 3x thence S20 E13.50 to a Red Oak 3x (near the head
 of a Branch) thence down the meanders of s^d Branch about 64.50 to
 an Ash 3x thence N14 E via Stake 3x on a Branch thence up the meand-
 ers of said Branch to the Beginning bounded on North by Lands of John
 Long South & West by H. Sullivan & South & East by Edmund Ragsdale &
 David Grayham. Together with all and singular the rights memb-
 ers hereditaments and Appurtenances to s^d premises belonging
 or in anywise incident or Appertaining to the same. to have & to hold
 all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Hewlet
 Sullivan his heirs & Assigns forever & we do hereby bind ourselves our
 heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant & forever defend all &
 singular the said premises unto the said Hewlet Sullivan his
 heirs & Assigns against ourselves & our heirs and against every other
 person lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
 Witness our hands & seals this 17th December in the Year of our Lord 1839
