South Carolina I know all men by these presents that I Thomas Greenville District Springfield of said district for and in consideration of the love and kindness which I have and do bear unto my daughter Nancy Miller have given and granted unto the said Nancy a certain tract of land containing forty three acres more or less situate in the said district on both sides of the Buncombe Road and waters of Enoree River it being the land on which the said Nancy now resides and hath such bounds marks &c as follows viz.

Beginning at a Blk Gum 3x on a Branch thereof N48°W33.50 chs to a Stake 3x on Mackrells line thence with said line E38W6.50 chs to a chestnut bush 3x thence S55°E 1ch to a Stake 3x thence S31W17.50 to a stump & pointers 3x thence S81°E 24 chs to a Blk Gum 3x on the aforesaid branch thence down the meanders of said branch to the beginning corner but it is to be especially understood that I do not intend my aforesaid daughter Nancy to have any further right to said land only during her natural life and should she the said Nancy or her husband sell or convey her life estate in said land it is to vest immediately in my Grandson Thomas Springfield Miller And it is further to be understood that at the death of my said daughter Nancy the aforesaid land is to be the property of my said Grandson Thomas Springfield Miller to him his heirs or assigns forever In confirmation of which I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 9<sup>th</sup> day of October 1840
