certify unto all whom it may concern, that Mrs. Maria
Williams the wife of the within named Thomas B. Williams
did this day appear before me and upon being privately
and separately examined by me, did declare that she does
freely voluntarily and without any compulsion, dread or fear
of any person or persons whomsoever renounce, release and
forever relinquish unto the within named Jeremiah Cleveland
his heirs and assigns all her interest and estate, and also
all her right and claim of power, of in, or to all singular
the Premises within mentioned and released

South Carolina I know all men by these presents that I Jeremiah
Greenville District Cleveland of the State and district aforesaid
for and in consideration of sixty dollars to me paid by Jabez
Bradley of the State and district aforesaid have released
and sold and by these presents do release and sell unto
the aforesaid Jabez Bradley his Heirs and assigns forever
the lower part of a certain tract of land ⁴⁰⁰ conveyed to
William Grawby Joseph Saloway supposed to contain
fifty acres situated in Greenville district and State
aforesaid lying on the north side of the south fork of
Sugger River. Containing lands laid out for Randolph camp.

Beginning at a Stake running thence N 70° E 27 to a
Black Oak thence North to a condertrial line thence
along said line to the opposite line thence to the beginning
Together with all and singular the rights members and
hereditaments therunto belonging to have and to hold all
and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said
Jabez Bradley his heirs and assigns forever and I do
freely bind myself my Heirs and assigns to warrant
and forever defend all and singular the titles to the said
lands to the said Jabez Bradley against myself my heirs
and no others. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal this the 17th day of January
1839. the words to the said language interlined before signed
signed sealed and delivered in presence
