




fourth acres of land laid out as follows beginning on a R. 03x
on Pollards live thence N 87 W. 3 ch^s to Stake on the Road &
thence N 24 W. to P. Oak 3x on the Road thence N 35 E 19 Chain
to Ash 3x near Poplar in head of Spring branch N 36 W. 120 to N. Oak
3x thence N 51 E 180 to B. Gum 3x thence up the branch to poplar
in the head of branch thence S 24 E 5.75 to Oak 3x near the meeting
House thence S 31¹/2 W. 15.50 to Red Oak 3x the Beginning corner
including nine and $\frac{1}{4}$ acres together with all and singular
the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the
said Premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining
to have and to hold all and singular the premises before
mentioned unto the said John J. Mayfield his heirs & assigns
for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors
and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all
and singular the said premises unto the said John J.
Mayfield his heirs and assigns against myself and my
heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming
the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and
seal this 26th day of January 1839 and in the 63rd year
of independence of the U. S. A.
