


aforesaid have in consideration of the sum of Forty five dollars to me  
paid by Abner B. Dunahoo of the district and State aforesaid have granted  
bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell  
and release unto the said Dunahoo sixteen and two thirds acres of land  
it being all my interest in the land whereon Bunnells Dell now lies as my  
respective share of the real Estate of David Dunahoo Dec<sup>d</sup>  
Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and  
appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or  
appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before  
mentioned unto said Dunahoo his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby  
bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant & forever  
defend all and singular the said premises unto the said A. B. Dunahoo  
his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every  
person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part  
thereof. Witness our hands and seals this 13<sup>th</sup> Janry 1836
