the 17<sup>th</sup> day of July 1846

State of South Carolina I know all men by these presents that  
Greenville District I, John Benson of the District of Greenville  
and State of South Carolina for and in Consideration of the sum of  
Fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by P E Duncan of the District  
and State aforesaid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged  
have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents  
do grant bargain sell release unto the said P E Duncan all that tract  
or parcel of land situate lying and being in the District and State  
aforesaid as hereinafter more particularly described beginning at a  
Black Oak & on the line between the said John Benson and the said  
P E Duncan On the West side of Reedy River and about thirty  
Yards from the Edge of the River swamp thence a North West  
direction nearly parallel with the Edge of said swamp crossing  
a small branch to a Red Oak & at the edge of said Benson's  
old field thence near a north course through the edge of  
the old field and nearly parallel with the Edge of Reedy-  
River swamp to a Spanish Oak & on the Conditional line
