fully appear. Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Her-
editaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or
in anywise incident or appertaining, I have and to hold all and
singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said J. H. Benedict
his Heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my Heirs
Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend
all and singular the said Premises unto the said J. H. Benedict
his Heirs and assigns against myself and my Heirs and
against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim
the same or any part thereof.
