state of South Carolina and Greenville District do for and in consideration
of the natural love and affection I do bear towards my son Randal
Taylor of the state and district aforesaid have granted given released
and made over and by these presents do give grant release and
make over unto the said Randal Taylor all that Tract or parcel
of Land supposed to contain fifty acres more or less situate in
Greenville District and State aforesaid on the Waters of Cane
Branch beginning on a Maple Corner on ^{said} branch joining Aaron
Cowell thence with said line to a Stake on Dudley Cowell's line
thence with said line to Joseph Edwards line thence with said line
to a Stake corner thence with said Edwards and John Andrews
line to Chestnut corner thence down the meander of the branch to
the beginning corner Together with all and singular the rights
members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises
belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining To have
and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
unto the said Randal Taylor his heirs and assigns forever
I do bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators
to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said
premises unto Randal Taylor against myself my heirs and
every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the
same or any part thereof In witness I have hereunto
set my hand and my affixed seal this 21st day of
December 1838 and in the sixty second year of American
Independence of America Signed Sealed and delivered in
the presence of Absalom Barney W^m A. Barney, William Taylor Seal

South Carolina { Personally appeared before me Absalom Barney
Greenville District, and made oath that he was present and
saw William Taylor (not sign seal the within deed of conveyance
to Randal Taylor his son for the use and purpose within mentioned
and also saith that he was present and saw W^m Barney sub-
cribe his name as a witness to the due execution of the same above
to and subscribed before me this 21st day of Decr 1838

Greenville Dist. have this day bought of J. H. Sutherland one two horse
Wagon on condition and credit until next October for which
I have gave my note and delivered him up my bay horse in
security on Wagon but they are to remain in possession of Mr.
McQuain until said note becomes due then if Mr. McQuain pays
off said note then this bill of sale to be null and void or otherwise
to remain in full force at law Dec. 10th day 1840
