

South Carolina. To all To whom these presents shall come -
I William M. Goodlett, Sheriff of Greenville district and State afore-
-said. send Greeting. Whereas by virtue of a writ of Fieri Facias
issued out of the Court of Common Pleas. held for the District
of Greenville tested the Fifth day of November in the year of Our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty at the suit of Josiah
Kelgore vs Moses M. Cray Executor of the Estate of William Daugherty
Dec. to me directed, commanding me, that of the goods and chattels
lands and tenements, of Moses M. Cray Exor. of Wm Daugherty, I was
to levy the sum of sixty dollars and seventy five cents - damages

bidder therefor. Now Know Ye, That I William M. Goodlett
Sheriff aforesaid, by virtue of the said Writ of Fieri Facias aforesaid
to me directed and delivered as aforesaid, and by virtue of the
Statute in such case made and provided, and for and in con-
sideration of the said sum of six hundred and five dollars
to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said
Robert League the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby
acknowledge have granted bargained sold and by these presents
do grant bargain and sell unto the said Robert League his
heirs and assigns forever the said tract piece and parcel
of lands with its appurtenances and all the estate right
title and interest which the said Moses M. Cray Exor of Wm.
Daugherty of right had of in and to the same -

To have and to hold the said piece parcel of land with
its appurtenances unto the said Robert League his heirs and
assigns forever, as fully and absolutely as I the said William
M. Goodlett as Sheriff aforesaid might could or ought to
grant bargain and sell the same, by virtue of the Statute
aforesaid the said Writ of fieri facias or otherwise. In Witness whereof I the said
