Greenville District } Goodlett esquire Sheriff of Greenville District by
virtue of a Writ of Fi. Fa. issuing from the Court of Common Pleas
wherein Jeremiah Cleaveland (et. al.) Plaintiffs and John Farr
Defendant, commanding me of the Goods and Chattels, Har-
ses, Lands, hereditaments and real estates of the said
John Farr to levy the sum of One hundred and fifty nine
dollars and eight cents besides Interests and costs. I have
taken two negro Girls (viz) Ann and Mary, as the property
of the said John Farr and sold the said Negroes according
to Law to Ambrose Reid for the sum of six Hundred & fifteen
Dollars being the highest bid offered therefor, whereby I have
by virtue of my Office, as Sheriff, bargained and sold and
delivered the said negro Slaves to the said Ambrose Reid
in as full and complete a manner as I ought or could
do by virtue of my said Office:
