Unto all whom it may concern That Mary Austin the
wife of the within named Vincent Austin did this day come before
me and upon being privately and separately examined by me did
declare that she does freely and voluntarily without any compulsion
dead or fear of any person whomsoever renounce release and for
ever relinquish all her right & claim of power to the premises within
mentioned & released unto the within named Isaac Kirby his heirs
or assigns - Given under my hand & seal this 28th November

Greenville District ³ Kirby of the state and district aforesaid in con-
sideration of the sum of Seven hundred dollars
to me paid by Tully Bolling of the said State and district aforesaid
and have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these pres-
ent do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Tully Bolling
a plantation and tract of land of Land laying in the state
and district aforesaid on the waters of Mountain Creek of Saluda
River beginning on a Sourwood tree thence running N 31° 31' to R
Oak 3x dead bounded by William Gwinpott and crossing the Augusta
Road. thence N 30° W. 770 to a stake 3x thence S 50° 33' to a chestnut 3x
bounded by the said Tully Bolling thence N 9° E. 20 to a stake 3x thence E.
80 to a R 3x thence N 37° W. 3 to a R 3x thence S 10° E. 3 to R 3x on the line runn-
ing N 80° E. then on said line 100 feet 30.57 so as to leave out a spring
to the beginning bounded by Land that John Kirby lately owned contain-
ing Ninetythree acres (but the same more or less) Together with
all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurten-
ances to the same belonging or in anywise incident or appertain-
ing - To Have and To Hold all and singular the said premises
unto the said Tully Bolling "his heirs and assigns" forever.

And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and
Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular
the said premises unto the said Tully Bolling his heirs and
