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The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that Luke Hampton
Greenville District of the State and District aforesaid in consider-
ation of the sum of one Ten Hundred and
Ninety two dollars to me in hand paid by Tully Bolling of the said State
and district aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Tully Bolling a planta-
tion and tract of Land laying in the estate and District aforesaid on
the waters of Mountain Creek of Saluda River it being the tracts of land that
I bought from William Williams containing one hundred and seventy
six acres a small tract I bought from Noah Cobb containing eleven
acres and the tract that I bought from John H Garrison containing
two hundred and fifty acres; beginning on a Red Oak being a
corner for the tract I got from Williams and the tract I got
from Garrison) thence running N 60 E 57 to a Stake bounded by
land that the said Tully Bolling got from Isham Garrison
hence S 80 W 5 to a Stake thence N 45 W 30 to a Stake thence S 80 W 15.
