 Greenville District that I Robert Pitman of the State  
 and District aforesaid have for and in consideration  
 of the sum of thirty five Dollars to me in hand paid  
 by Wm W. Robertson of the State and District the receipt  
 whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained, sold  
 and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell  
 release and confirm and convey unto the said Wm W  
 Robertson a part of a tract of land containing one hundred  
 acres more or less situated lying and being in the State  
 and District aforesaid on the head of Pastons fork of Tyger  
 River beginning on at Robertson red Oak corner between  
 Wm W. Robertson and Thomas Howard, thence running with  
 Thomas Howard line to his Chesnut corner, thence to  
 the top of the mountain to a chestnut, thence running  
 the main top of ridge to Charles Sotherline corner the  
 conditional corner between Charles Sotherline and Roberts  
 Pitman, thence running with the conditional line between  
 Charles Sotherline and Robert Pitman to a conditional  
 corner between the said Robertson and Charles Sotherline,  
 thence bounding on the said Robertson line to the  
 beginning corner to which the said Robert Pitman  
 has bargained, sold and delivered unto the said  
 Wm W. Robertson and do bind myself heirs and  
 executors Administrators to warrant and forever  
 defende all rights unto the said Robertson his  
 heirs and executors and every other person or  
 persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim  
 the same or any part thereof Witness my hand  
 and seal this thirtieth day of December in the  
 Year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred  
 and thirty seven signed sealed and delivered in the
