South Carolina, Greenville District, Know all men by these presents that I William S. Dill of the State and District aforesaid in the consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars to me paid by Thomas Mosley of the State and District have granted bargained sold and released unto the said Thomas Mosley a plantation or tract of land lying in Greenville District and State aforesaid on the waters of South Syger River at the East end of pack mountain beginning at a large rock on a chestnut oak running thence N. 70° W. 54 chains 77 links to a Chestnut Corner thence W. 20. 18. 26 to a Stake Corner thence nearly S. 70° E. 34. 77 links to a Stake Corner near to dokeys line thence N. 20. E. 18. 26 links to the Beginning containing of One hundred Acres to the same more or less conveyed from William S. Dill to Thomas Mosley together with all and singular rights member hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging or anywise appertaining to have and to hold all the premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas Mosley his heirs and assigns forever I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors administrators to warrant and for defend unto the said Thomas Mosley his assigns forever against myself my heirs and against all and every other person
