 Know all men by these presents that I Waddy Thompson Jr for and in consideration of twenty acres of land to me conveyed by Deed bearing date even with these presents have given granted bargained and sold & do by these presents give grant bargain and sell to Elisha Green Esqr all that portion of land containing twenty acres more or less being part of a tract originally granted to Thomas Sibree and having such marks and boundaries as will appear by reference to a plat herunto annexed.

To have and to hold the said tract of land together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to the said Elisha Green his heirs & assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant forever defend all and singular the premises to the said Elisha Green his heirs and assigns against the claim of all manner of persons whomsoever.
