T. Rowland deceased for and in consideration of the sum of
Two Thousand Seven Hundred dollars to us in hand paid by
Barnet Statham the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
Have granted, bargained, sold, released, and conveyed and
by these presents do grant, bargain, sell release and convey
unto the said Barnet Statham his heirs and assigns all that
tract or plantation of land, situate lying and being the
District and State aforesaid on the West side of the road,
leading from Greenville to Rutherford, beginning at a Post
Oak corner near E. D. Earle's thence N. 43. E 150 to a Black Oak
thence E. 5. 25 to a Stake on the Rutherford Road, and thence
with said Road in a North East direction 27. 20 to a
Stake thence N. 65. W. 27. 25 to a Stake, thence S. 45. W. 13. 10 to
a Stake E. D. Earle's corner, thence 36 1/2 East 39 chains to the
beginning containing seventy acres more or less bounded
on the East by G. B. Stoms land, and lands of the
estate of W. T. Rowland dec'd and on the North by land of the
said estate and on the West by E. D. Earle's land being the
place whereon we now live which was laid off to as the
inheritance or part thereof of the said Sophia St. Earle
