that I John Smith of the state and district aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by G. F. Townes comm^r in Equity for Greenville District the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold granted and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release to the said G. F. Townes, Com^r in Equity aforesaid and to his successors in Office the following tract of land situate lying and being in Greenville district and State aforesaid on the head branch of South Tyger River at the foot of Pop Mountain adjoining lands now owned by David Jackson called the Mowson beginning on a Post Oak corner
