James Pickett & Agreement  
Belvanda Holcombe

The State of South Carolina Agreement and  
Greenville District bargain entered  
into betwixt James Pickett of the One Part and Belvanda Hol-  
combe of the second part and Kinchin Holcombe trustee for  
the said Belvanda Holcombe of the third part. witnesseth that  
the said James Pickett and Belvanda Holcombe and Kinchin  
Holcombe trustee doth covenant and agree, that the said  
Pickett and Belvanda Holcombe shall unite in marriage  
And that if either the said James Pickett or the said Belv-  
anda Holcombe shall become dissatisfied after marriage  
at any future time either with or without a cause then the  
said James Pickett and the said Belvanda Holcombe which  
they may be Belvanda Pickett the wife of the said James  
Pickett shall separate and finally shall be as unmarried  
persons without any hindrance whatsoever and that the  
said James Pickett shall pay the said Belvanda Holcombe  
then Belvanda Pickett two Hundred Dollars which shall  
be in lieu of all Power whatsoever and that the said Belv-  
anda Holcombe then Belvanda Pickett shall withdraw  
and move off from the said James Pickett. But and if  
the said James Pickett and the said Belvanda Holcombe then  
Belvanda Pickett do live together quietly and peaceably  
and in good feeling with each other during of the life of  
the said James Pickett then the said James Pickett or  
his assigns shall pay the said Belvanda Pickett One  
thousand dollars which shall be kept at legal
