This instrument is made at Wittington Le. 13 day of Feb^r 1852
State and District aforesaid was got from his Father Estate
a few years ago a tract of Land ^{and} to him by commission
appointed by the Court of Equity to divide the real
estate of Captain Berry aforesd. Now I the said Witting-
ton Berry am considerate of the sum of one thousand
Dollars to me paid by William R. Berry of the
State and District aforesaid having granted and gained
sold and released and by this instrument do grant Captain
Berry and his executors to this paid William R. Berry a.
mill of Land (a vine named) lying in the State and
District aforesaid on the Little River, fork of Roaring
River containing two hundred and forty acres & the
same more or less than a mile ^{from} the lands belonging to C. P.
Berry Dr J. C. Sullivan Sonnleitner, William Smith
and Jas. Garrison (Siddall place)

I do with all and singular the rights more less
hered, grants and assignments to said premises per-
taining or in any wise incident or pertaining
to have and to hold all and singular the premises before
mentioned unto the said Capt. William R. Berry his heirs
and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my
heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever
defend all and singular the premises to the said
William R. Berry his heirs and assigns from myself and
my heirs and from every person whomsoever lawfully
claiming or to claim the same on any part thereof
Without paying him and seal this 22nd of Feat A. D. 1852.
