Whereas William Jacobs son, on or about the twentieth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty three did exhibit his bill of complaint in the Court of Equity at Greenwell Co. Geo. in the said State against William Jacobs Sr. and others praying the partition of certain lands more particularly specified in said Bill the property of the late John B. Jacobs deceased And the cause being at issue before the Honorable Court came on to be heard at Chambers in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty three when the said Court after full hearing view and mature deliberation in the premises did order Adjudge and decree that the said Land mentioned in said petition should be sold at Public Auction by the Commissioner of said Court on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in their Decreeal Order as by reference thereto in the Registry of the said Court will appear And the said Samuel A. Townes as Commissioner of the said Court after having duly advertised the said Land for sale at Public Auction on the 5th day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty four did thereupon and
