sell and release unto the said Joseph May his heirs and assigns all that tract
or parcel of land lying and being in the State and District aforesaid on the waters
of Marsh Creek known as the John Russell place containing 350 acres more
or less bounded by lands of Moses Fowler & A Meany, Amos Morris
J Scheldus Estelle West, W H Westinck, Henry Bailey and lands belonging
to the estate of Mrs Welch. It being the tract of land upon which James W May
now now lies. Together with all and singular the rights memberments
and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining
To have and to hold all and singular the premises above
mentioned unto the said Joseph May his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby
bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and defend
and will defend the said premises unto the said Joseph May his heirs
and assigns against myself and my heirs and against no other person
or persons.
