tenant. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before  
mentioned unto the said J. H. Cleveland his heirs and assigns forever and  
I do hereby bind myself heirs and executors and administrators to wear  
rank and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the  
said J. H. Cleveland his heirs and assigns against myself and my  
heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to  
claim the same or any part thereof.
