church of Christ Church Greenville in consideration of the said Bond and
sum of money aforesaid doth for the better securing the payment thereof to the
said Protestant Episcopal Society for the advancement of Christianity in South
Carolina according to the condition of the said Bond and also in consid-
eration of the sum of Three dollars to the said Protestant Episcopal
Church of Christ Church Greenville in hand well and truly paid by
by the said Protestant Episcopal Society for the advancement of Christianity
in South Carolina at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged to have granted, bargained,
sold, and released unto these presents do grant, bargain sell
and release unto the said Protestant Episcopal Society for the ad-
vancement of Christianity in South Carolina all that the aforesaid of land
situate lying and being in the North East portion of the Town of Greenville
in the State of South Carolina Beginning at a Stake and running
thence NW 22 1/2 feet thence 100 feet due South and one half feck to a small
pond or hole thence N 44 1/2 degrees thence 100 feet due East
thence 16 1/2 feet bounded and forty five feet to a Stake 34 Paces 1716
