Together with all thoughts, memories, recollecting  
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise im-  
plied or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the  
premises before mentioned unto the said Williams W. of his heirs  
and assigns forever. And hereby I do myself, my heirs and  
executors and administrators to warrant and defend all and singular  
the said premises unto the said Williams W. of his heirs and  
assigns against myself, my heirs and against every person whom  
ever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

Witness my hand and seal this 1st day of February  
A.D. 1854 and in the Seventy Eighth year of American Independence.
