Articles of Agreement entered into between Colonel Wilson Parton and his wife Mrs Rebecca Parton as to their future separation and living apart from each other. It is mutually agreed between the parties that they do separate and live apart from each other. Colonel Wilson Parton agrees to take on his part the following negro slaves which came by Mrs Parton (viz) Spencer his wife Mahaly and her four children Martha, Lucy, Lizzy and William. He is to retain the 24 hundred and sixty three dollars received of Davis Hooper on account of the Mills on the tract of Land which was to have been his in due time of the marriage settlement between him and his wife Rebecca Parton.
