

In Sparce which is now partitioned by the parties. She received five hundred Dollars for her claim to the tract of land known as the Fox Tract mentioned in the marriage contract which she retains. She has received the rent corn on the said Tract of land during the past year which she is to have. The said Parties is also to have the present stock of provisions, corn and groceries, on the Home place at the time provided the said Rebecca Barton does not continue to reside on the said place if she continues to have there all the said Stock of provisions, corn, food &c and so forth and to her credit.

In consideration of the above enumerated property which came by Mrs. Rebecca Barton at her marriage with the said Wilson Barton and which property the said Wilson Barton is to have and retain as his own farm. She the said Wilson Barton gives up and by these presents relinquishes all and goes to her former husband Colv Benjamin Haggard in a separate tract as Trustee for Mrs. Barton all other interest which she now has or may hereafter have in any and all the other property which belongs to Mrs. Rebecca Barton previous to her marriage with him and also all interest which she may have in and under the marriage settlement made between him and his said wife Rebecca Barton at their marriage not above specified.

Mrs. Rebecca Barton on her part is to receive thing left the Trustee Colv Benjamin Haggard immediately from her husband Colv Wilson Barton the following property which is to be given to her and her heirs forever, exclusive of her said husband (viz) The Home place on which she now lives and which was purchased by her at the division of High Blawee Estate on Cherry Creek the waters of Saluda River bounded by lands of James Hodges, Jeffreys, Beantill and others the following negro slaves Daniel, Veria, Tom, Armstrong, Charles, and Hamet and then increase the household and kitchen furniture, Stock of all kinds, cattle, horses and hogs. The cattle and hogs are to be made the same in number that were on the place at the marriage of the parties. The horses are to be made of the same value as when the marriage took place. The said Rebecca Barton is to retain all her notes and money which she had at her former marriage with the said Colv Wilson Barton and which have not been reduced to her possession. The Stock of provision already mentioned as being on the Home place is to be the said Rebecca Barton provided she continues to live there otherwise to be Colv Wilson Barton.

In consideration of the above property which is to be conveyed to Mrs. Bartons Trustee Colv Benjamin Haggard for her sole use and benefit she relinquishes all claim on the said Colv Wilson Barton for any support or maintenance from him and also all claim or interest whatsoever which she may have in this estate or property or the property which the said Wilson Barton now retains unless received of her. She also relinquishes all claims which she has under the marriage contract between her and the said Husband in accordance with the agreement in the case of the death of Colv Barton and before her the said Rebecca is not to dispute or claim the property now possessed by the said Colv W. Barton and in as much as she is a female person she cannot legally make a contract in law she esteems the best way to settle
