Weyley to me in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by W. D. Weyley Trustee for the said Henry D. Weyley who is a minor and do act as such till he arrives at the age of twenty one the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain sell and deliver to the said W. D. Weyley in Trust for the said Henry D. Weyley till he arrives at the age of twenty one and then to have the said Henry D. Weyley discharged of the said Trust the following slaves Thomas son of Phoeby, Matilda daughter of Betty also, blank &c

To have and to hold the said Three negroes slaves above mentioned and their increase unto the said W. D. Weyley Trustee for Henry D. Weyley till he arrives at the age of twenty one and then to the said Henry D. Weyley free of such Trust his Executors, Administrators and assigns so long and his only proper use and behoof forever And I the said Sarah C. Weyley my Executors, Administrators the said Care and premises unto the said W. D. Weyley in Trust for Henry D. Weyley discharged of said Trust his Executors and Administrators and assigns from and against all persons shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents

In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal dated at Greenville on the 9th day of March in the year of our Lord one Thousand eight hundred and fifty five and in the 78th year of the Independence of the United States of America
