Samuel Dayley of Greenville District in the State of South Carolina in consideration of the love and affection I bear towards my son in law John Love and for the air and comfort which I have received from him for many years past and for the sum of five dollars to me in hand paid have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John Love My That I had a parcel of land situate lying and being in the District and State of South Carolina containing Two hundred and six acres more or less adjoining lands of Sterling McQueen David Daily Joseph McMillon and others

Together with all and singular the Rights Members and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said John Love his Heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my Heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said John Love his Heirs and assigns against me and my Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof

Witness my hand and seal this 27th day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty four and in the seventh seventh year of the Independence of the United States of America
