Hundred and Sixty nine dollars and Sixty cents to me paid by Sahay Gilbreath
of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and
released and by these presents do Grant his gain sell and release unto the said
Sahay Gilbreath all That Piece of Land and Tract of Land lying and being
in the District aforesaid or State aforesaid on branch waters of Hickory Creek of
Reedy River Beginning on a Dogwood which said Dogwood is also a corner
of a Tract of Land belonging formerly to Gilbreath 37 rods from N 75 W
along the of said Sahay Gilbreath Game 24 chains 51 links to Rock Oak 37
Pence N 54 W 3.50 to a Sycamore Stake of Thence along the line of
Hammond's Land 31 rods E 9.75 to a Red Oak 37 Thence N 66 E 37 rods
to a Rock Oak 37 Thence N 39 W 37 rods to the beginning corner
containing Twenty six acres Thence 20 rods and twenty four poles
(24. 3. 25) more or less and forth such length and form as a plot
of the same will reasonably represent

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Boundaries
and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident
or appertaining

To have and to hold all and singular the premises by
me mentioned unto the said Sahay Gilbreath and to his Heirs and assigns
forever And I do hereby bind myself my Heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises
unto the said Sahay Gilbreath His Heirs and assigns against me and
my Heirs and against every person whosoever lawfully claiming
or to claim the same or any part thereof
