incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the premises before  
mentioned unto the said John W Jones his heirs and assigns forever  
I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant  
and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said John  
W Jones his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against  
every person wheresoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part  
thereof.

Witness my hand and seal this twenty fourth day of March in the  
Year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty four and in the  
Seventy Eighth year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States  
of America.
