Know all men by these presents That I Clem Ray of Greenville District in the State of South Carolina doth in consideration of Five Thousand and Seventy Five dollars to me paid by Meagahle Smith of Greenville District in the State of South Carolina doth Bargain and sell to his released and by these presents do grant lease and all and release unto the said Meagahle C Smith all that piece, parcels or tract of lying and being in the District and State aforesaid on both sides of Hink's Fork of Saluda River beginning on a little oak 34 in Thence S 37° 46' 48" to a pine 37 34 in. down Hink's Fork 46' 43" to a poplar 34 34 in near the creek then S 37° 44' W 37° 41 to a chestnut oak 34 in Thence S 35° 40' back to the beginning and at corner bearing due by a line running S E by East of Abantells C.C. 47 44 and S E by lines vacant and of Rightwes land the said tract containing thunders and eighty acres more or less.

Together with all and singular the Rights, privileges, franchises, immunitiess and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Meagahle C Smith his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Meagahle C Smith his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and any person or persons whatsoever lawfully claiming a to claim the same or any part thereof.
