That in pursuance of directions and authority to us for that purpose given in and by the last will and testament of Edward Croft deceased we Marshall Croft Theodore Croft and Charles Elford as executors of the last will and testament of Greenville District in the State aforesaid in consideration of Four hundred and Thirty Dollars to us paid by Salathiel Martin of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted, bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Salathiel Martin all that piece, parcel and lot of Land situate lying and being in the Town of Greenville in the District and State aforesaid and bounded as follows Beginning at a Stake at the intersection of a cross street forty feet wide with the Lanes Road and running thence W by E with said Lanes road one hundred and Twenty five feet to a Stake at or lot sold by us to Mr B Earle thence N 12 40 From hundred and forty seven and a half feet with said Earles line to a stake on a back street thirty feet wide thence S 74 40 with said back street one hundred and forty seven feet to a stake at the cross street first above mentioned thence S 8 E with said cross street four hundred and fifty feet to the beginning corner containing one and three fifths of an acre more or less and being said land has Lot No 3 in the plan of lots belonging to estate of Edward Croft deceased on the Lanes Road as will appear by a plat hereto attached

Together with all and singular the Rights members tenements and appurtenances to the said premises better giving or in any wise incident or pertaining to have and to hold to all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Salathiel Martin his Heirs and assigns forever And we do hereby bind the said Edward Crofts heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Salathiel Martin his Heirs and assigns against them and their Heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness our hands and seals this first day of October in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty three and in the Seventy eighth year of the Independence of the United States of America a
