I knowe that in consideration of your integrity and skill full power is hereby given to you (or any two or more of you) To take the Relinquishment of Mourning D. Luckworth the wife of E. Luckworth of Delgado More House Parish in the State of Louisiana of her estate and inheritance in the premises described in the Recd attached For this purpose you will cause the said Mourning D. Luckworth to appear before you and you will examine her privately and separately apart from all other persons and if upon such examination she shall freely declare that she did at least seven days before such examination actually join her husband in executing the Recd of Release aforesaid that the said release was positively and bona fide executed at least seven day before such her examination and that she did then at the execution of the said release and still does at the time of her examination freely voluntarily and without any manner of Compulsion deed or fear by any person or persons whatsoever renounce, release, and forever relinquish all her estate interest and inheritance in the premises mentioned and conveyed in the said release unto Samuel H Garrison S. H Garrison and their heirs and assigns

And also full power is hereby given to you or any two or more of you to take Probate of the execution of the said Recd aforesaid attached to M. S. Greenwell and Mourning D. Luckworth dated the Fifth day of June A. D. 1854 to Samuel H Garrison and S. H Garrison of Greenville District in the State of South Carolina For this purpose you shall cause one of the subscribing witnesses of the Recd aforesaid to appear before you and having administered to him (as you are hereby fully authorized to do) an oath or solemn affirmation according to the form of his religious persuasion that this affidavit is true you shall take under his hand an affidavit that he was personally present and saw E. Luckworth and Mourning D. Luckworth his wife sign Seal and deliver the Recd aforesaid for the uses and purposes and intentions expressed in that he and the subscribing witness signed their names thereto as witnesses of its due execution which affidavits authenticated under your hands and seals you shall annex to this writ

And having certified under your hands and seals the due execution of this Writ and verified the same by the oath of one of you before some Magistrate who is authorized by the Laws of your State to administer an oath and whose official signature may be properly authenticated

You shall carefully return this Writ together with your proceedings thereon to the Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas and General Sessions for Greenville District in the State aforesaid to be duly recorded. Herein fail not Peter Q. Hobbs Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas
