 thence S 20° E 57. to a red oak thence N 15.50 to a pine thence
 N 34° E 29.50 to a chestnut thence to the beginning

Together with all and singular the right members
 appertaining thereto belonging & I do hereby bind myself my heirs
 executors administrators to warrant and forever defend the above mentioned
 premises unto the said John Russell his heirs and assigns forever
 claiming the same or any part thereof against all persons lawfully
 in anywise
