tract or parcel of Land or waters of Saluda River, Bounded as follow
by containing one hundred and fifty seven acres be the same more or
less Beginning at the gum corner Mr 186 to a pine Thence up the
Ridge 22 to Rd S 18th 36.00 to Rock S 7th 44th 32.00 to Rd. 0 Thence S 43rd
65.00 to the beginning.

To have and to hold the above granted premises
unto the said Bennet Freeman his heirs and assigns forever

To goeth with all and singular the rights hereby
hereinafter and appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise incident
or appertaining unto the said Martin Howitt do hereby bind myself
my heirs and assigns forever to warrant and defend the above granted
premises unto the said Bennet Freeman his heirs and assigns against
myself, my heirs and assigns and against any and every other person
or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
