sideration of the sum of Eight hundred dollars to me in hand paid  
by John S Ashmore of the state and district aforesaid now bargained  
and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto John S  
Ashmore a certain tract of land containing one hundred and forty  
one acres more or less lying on the waters of the Head Fork beginning  
on a pine corner Thence N 88 W 14.50 to a stone Thence N 34 W 12.  
50 to R. O Thence S 68 W 3.50 to R. O Thence N 62 W 5.20 to maple  
stone with the meanders of the branch to ash distanced 20 chains  
Thence S 35 W 11.50 to Pine Stump Thence S 34 E 26 to stone Thence  
N 79 E 21.50 to stone on the branch Thence N 54 E 16.50 to maple  
stone with the meanders of the branch to maple Thence N 18  
W. 80 to the beginning which includes the land hereinabove  
being One hundred and forty one acres more or less

Together with all and singular the rights, members  
appurtenances unto the said premises belonging or in any wise incident  
or appertaining.
