To now all men by these presents
that I Samuel Henry Dickson, Doctor
of Medicine, of the City of Charleston
and State of aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of four
hundred and fifty (\$450) Dollars, to me in hand paid, (the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted bargain, sell and re-
leased, and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and release unto
the said John Mc Jones, all that piece or parcel of land known as
the Dickson tract or Dickson Reserve, situate, lying and being in
the district of Greenville and State of aforesaid, about four miles east
East of the village of Greenville, in the tract to Mathew Hudson,
measuring and containing one hundred and fourteen (114) Acres more
or less, and defined by the following corners & marks, courses & distances
that is to say, beginning at a dead Spk. 10 near the Church House
and running thence S 8 W 7. 70 to a Chestnut Oak R, thence S 28, E 55. 00
to a stake, thence N 41, E 13. 60 to a stake, thence N 75 E 14. 60 to a Post oak,
and thence by the out line of the Howard Tract, to the corner above mentioned
near the Church House. Together with all and singular the rights mem-
bers, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or
in anywise incident or appertaining. To Have and to hold, all and
singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said John Mc Jones
his heirs and assigns forever. And I the said Samuel Henry Dickson
do hereby bind myself, my heirs, Executors & Administrators, to warrant
and forever defend, all and singular the said Premises, unto the said
John Mc Jones, his heirs and assigns, against me, and my heirs and
assigns, and all others lawfully claiming or to claim the same in any part
thereof. Witness my hand and seal this sixth day of November in the year of
our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and fiftyfour, and in the seventy ninth
year of the sovereignty and independence of the United States of America
