I Avery Buff of Greenville District and of said state in consideration of Two thousand dollars to me paid by John Westfield of Greenville District and state aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John Westfield all that tract or parcel of Land containing one hundred and eighty six acres more or less, situated in the District and state aforesaid, it being the same tract or parcel of Land conveyed by Edmund Wood to the said Avery Buff by a deed bearing date the 17th day of August AD 1816, bounded and described as follows Beginning at the confluence of Mill Creek on Saluda river thence down the meanders of said River to a Red O. thence S 88 E 7.50 to a Post Oak thence S 88 E 37.5 to a pine, thence N 88 E 19.50 to a pine, thence S 82 E 32.25 to a Red O. thence S 46 E 8 to a Post O. thence N 58 E 22.50 to a large Poplar on a branch thence down the meander of said
