Know all men by these presents that
William Choice of Greenville Village
in the aforesaid state, in consideration
of one thousand dollars to me paid by T. G. McClannaham, Daniel Franks,
James R. Connelson, P. B. Burham & J. W. Westmacott commissioners of
the poor in and for Greenville District in the state of aforesaid, have
granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant
bargain sell and release unto the said commissioners of the poor and their
successors in office all that tract of Land situated lying and being in
the District of Greenville and state of aforesaid. Beginning at a tree S. and
running N. 39° E. 34 rods to a hickory tree thence N. 72° E. 29 rods
to another on the hickory tree thence W. 11 rods to a hickory stump tree thence S. E. W. 28
to a small black Gum tree, thence N. 17° E. 44 rods to a stake, thence down a branch to a water
oak tree, thence S. 32° W. 10 rods to a Spanish O. tree thence N. 10° E. the ford on the branch
thence to the beginning corner containing one hundred and forty two acres of
land more or less as will appear by reference to the plat made by J. C. Boylston
and recorded in the Register of Deeds dated the 14th of January 1853.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident
or pertaining.

I have and do hold all and singular the premises
before mentioned, unto the said Commissioners of the Poor for Greenville
District and their successors in office and assigns forever. And I do
hereby bind myself my heirs executors, administrators to warrant and for
ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Commissioners
of the poor and their successors in office and assigns, against myself
and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming
or to claim the same or any part thereof.
