It now be that in consideration of your illegally and s kill, full power
is hereby given to you to take the renunciation of Mary Powell wife
of Joseph Powell of Greenville District in the state of South Carolina
of her power above in the premises described in the dec. from Joseph
Powell to John J. McDaniel dated the 31st day of October in the
same eight hundred and fifty four conveying a certain lot of Land lying
and being in the village of Greenville containing or half acre more
or less adjoining the lot of Henry Glenn on a street running down
from the Episcopal church towards the river and immediately oppo-
site to John Durup lot. Beginning at a rock corner of said lot
Eastward and running up said street forty seven feet more or less to
the fence adjoining the pasture of the house where C. A. Lammie now
lives thence in a direct line across said lot, three hundred feet
to a small well to West Waddy Thompsons lot, thence down said street
forty seven feet to a rock corner in said Glenns line thence along said
line three hundred feet to the beginning.

In this purpose you will cause the said Mary Powell to
appear before you and you will examine her separately and privately
apart from all other persons, and if upon such examination she shall
freely declare that she does pay voluntarily and without any compul-
sion or fear of any person or persons whomsoever, her own
relax and forever relinquish to John J. McDaniel his heirs, assigns
and all her interest and estate and also all her right and claim of power
of in or to all and singular the premises described and conveyed in the de-
claration aforesaid.

Then you shall take under her hand a certificate of her renun-
ciation as aforesaid in the form of a declaration upon private examina-
tion as aforesaid, which certificate authenticated by your hands and
seals you shall annex to this writ. And having certified under your hands and
seals the due execution of this writ and verified the same by the oath of
one of you, before some magistrate who is authorized by the laws of your
state to administer oaths and whose official signature may be prop-
erly authenticated, you shall carefully return this writ, together with your
proceedings therein to the Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas, and
General Sessions for Greenville District in the state aforesaid to be
duly recorded. He or they fail not.
