

Waddy Thompson Deed with Carolina
J. Greenville District
of W Walker Lot

To you all men by these presents, that I Waddy Thompson of the District and State of South Carolina in consideration of the sum of Twelve hundred dollars to me received to be paid by J W Walker of the same State and District have given, granted, bargained, sold and do hereby by these presents give, grant, bargain & sell to the said J W Walker all that Lot of Land in the town of Greenville containing two acres more or less Beginning at a stake on avenue street, and a street 40 feet wide and runs 74 East thence thence 100 feet along avenue street to a stake on said street 40 feet wide between said Lot and J M Roberts Lot, thence North 16 E along the 40 feet street 340 feet to a stake, thence south 16 W along the street running by Joseph Powell's estate, to the Beginning on avenue street. I have and do hold the said lot of Land with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said J W Walker his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, Executors, and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises to the said J W Walker, his heirs and assigns against the claim or demand of all manner of persons whomsoever claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
