Being part of a tract of land originally granted to John Wheeler and thence conveyed to Aaron Templeman and from him and his heirs to George Linza, thence to Emanuel Linza and thence now to Jacob Linza together with all and singular the rights numbers, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and hold all and singular the said premises unto the said Jacob Linza his heirs and assigns forever.
