more or less and bounded as follows beginning on a Red C. S. on McHenry

land, thence N 39° W say 42 rods to a Stake, thence East 1/2 to

a stake thence nearly E. to a tree on the Creek thence down the Creek

to a Poplar to a Poplar on Benson's land, thence N 33° W to a pine

stump, thence N 37° W 28 rods to a P. C. thence west 2 rods to the begin-

ning corner. Together with all and singular the rights members in struc-

tions and appurtenances to the said tract of land belonging or in any

wise incident or pertaining. To have & to hold all and singular

the promises before mentioned unto the said Richard Goodlett his heirs

and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors

and Administrators and assigns to warrant and forever defend all

and singular the said promises unto the said Richard Goodlett his heirs

and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person

whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
