of Twenty five hundred Dollars to me paid by Alberto C Burgess, of  
Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted, bargained  
sold and released of and by these presents do grant, bargain sell  
and release unto the said Alberto C Burgess, all that Lot of Land  
situate, lying and being in the Town of Greenville in the District of  
State aforesaid, on the south side of Buncombe Street and at the  
corner of a street leading from Buncombe street, being bounded as  
follows: Beginning at a Stake on Buncombe street at the SW corner  
of lot belonging to the Est of J H Benedict deceased and running thence  
with Buncombe street 438  $\frac{1}{4}$  chain 20 links to the Crop Street, thence  
with said crop street 329 00 3 chains 6 links to a stake, thence with Bu-  
ncombe lot 318 0 50 links to a stake, thence still with Benedict's lot  
386 3 chains 8 links to the beginning corner, it being the lot  
conveyed to me by J H Benedict by Deed bearing date February 1853  
which is recorded in Book C Vol 1 at page 318 Register of conveyance.

Together with all and singular the rights  
members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises  
belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, to have and to  
hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the  
said Alberto C Burgess his heirs and assigns forever. And I do here  
by bind myself, my heirs, executors & administrators to warrant and  
forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said  
Alberto C Burgess his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs  
and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or  
to claim the same or any part thereof.
