 1848. and by which the remainder estate results to Robt Mc Burren on
 the termination of said life estate, and which estate in remainder was con-
 veyed to me the said J Arthur by said Robt Mc Burren by deed dated
 the eighth day of April January 1855, and the said remainder estate
 is conveyed to me I do hereby also convey to the said Mrs C Parkins.

Together with all and singular the rights members
 hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or
 in anywise incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular
 the premises before mentioned unto the said Mrs C Parkins
 her heirs & assigns forever. And I do hereby bind my self, my heirs
 executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all
 and singular the said premises unto the said Mrs C Parkins her
 heirs and assigns against my self and my heirs and against every
 person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any
