I A J Dunder of the State and District  
aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred  
and fourtene dollars to me paid in hand by John Campbell  
of the State and District above mentioned have granted, bargained  
sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and  
release unto the said John Campbell all that tract or parcel of  
Land containing two hundred and fifty eight acres to the same more or  
less situated in Greenville District and State above mentioned,  
lying on the waters of Pascotiger river, Beginning on Ridge, thence  
thence N 29 chains to White oak, thence S 44 W 14 chains to White  
oak, thence South 11 C 13 chs 84 links to Chestnut thence S 18 W  
11 chs 11 links to Red oak, thence N 87 E 7 chs 54 links to a  
Pine Stump, thence S 53 E 19 chs to Rock in place of Ridge oak  
stump, thence S 23 E 11 chs 54 links to Red oak S 48 E to a stake  
on the Branch thence S 35 W 11 chs to Po. oak, thence S 75 E  
19 chs to a Po. oak, thence S 34 E 19 chs 84 links to a Rock, thence  
N 82 W 45 chs 10 links to a Ridge oak thence S 24 W to a Stake on  
my olde original line, thence S 18 W to the Beginning corner.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, the  
sediments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging  
or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold  
all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said John  
Campbell his Heirs and assigns forever, And I do hereby bind  
myself my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant  
forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the  
said John Campbell his Heirs and assigns against myself  
and my Heirs and against every person or persons otherwise  
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof  
With my hand and seal this fourteenth day of January in the year  
of our Lord one thousand and eight hundred and fifty one and in  
the seventy fifth year of the Independence of the United States of  
America.
