St James Co, S.C. I do stand To all to whom these presents may concern
I Wesley Payne in the state aforesaid ^{saying} that

Whereas I the said Wesley Payne in and by my certaine bond or obligation
bearing date the 5th day of February 1855, stande firmly binded unto
Samuel A. Tonnes commisioner in equity for said district and the processes
in office in said District of said Tonnes in the penal sum of one thousand dollars
one hundred dollars conditioned for the payment of the full and just sum of six
hundred dollars, as in and by the said bond and condition thereof referred to herein
to being paid will more fully appear. Now know all men that I the said Wesley
Payne in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid and for the
better securing the payment thereof, to the said Samuel A. Tonnes according to the
conditions of said Bond and also in the further consideration of the sum of three
dollars to me the said Wesley Payne in hand well and truly paid by the said
Samuel A. Tonnes, at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged, I the said Wesley Payne have granted bargained
sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and release unto
the said Samuel A. Tonnes commisioner as of aforesaid tract of Plantation or
tract of Land situate lying and being situate in the District of Greenville and State
of aforesaid in waters of Reedy River adjoyning Barnold's Old Factory tract, No man
Hicks, Mrs McDaniels Land, containing one hundred and thirteen acres more or
less and is the same mentioned in the will of Samuel Crayton deceased
and purchased by him in his life time at Sheriff's sale and conveyed to James
McDaniel by T. D. Earle, William Choice and Mary G. Crayton Executrix
and Executrix of the last will and testamant of the said Samuel Crayton.

Together with all and singular the rights members, hereditaments
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise inci-
pient or appertaining. To have and to hold, all and singular the said Prem-
ises unto the said Tonnes his successors in office forever. And I the
said Wesley Payne do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors and ad-
ministrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said
