 second part, one black girl called Edna Quiza about
 eight years old together with her future increase said
 negro girl to have and hold all and singular the said
 negro with her increase unto the said J. Donaldson
 his successors and assigns in trust for the several
 uses intents and purposes hereinafter mentioned.
 First In trust to allow said girl to remain
 and continue in the possession of my said daughter
 and her husband for their use and benefit.
 In trust to all the said girl or any of her increase
 if she or any of them her increase if seized and log out
 the money for others to be paid in the same manner as
