And in this indenture witnesseth that in consideration of Six hundred and seventy eight dollars & 25<sup>cts</sup> to me paid & secured to be paid, I have granted bargain, sold and released & by these presents do grant bargain sell and release to the said Washington Taylor, and his heirs forever, all that tracts of Land situate in said Districts in Green river & adjoining lands of Marriage Green, Warringtons Kachine, Red Chick & others containing one hundred acres more or less.

With the appurtenances therunto belonging and the estate, right title, interest claim or demand whiche Austine Taylor died, at the time of his death had in or to the same. To have and to hold the said tracts of Land together with all and singular the premises and improvements, unto appurtenances to the said Austine Taylor his heirs and assigns forever. Witness wherof I the said L Mc Bee as ordinary aforesaid herunto set my hand and seal the day and year above mentioned.
