When all men of these presents that I John W Jones of the State and District aforesaid in and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars to me in hand paid by General Waddy Thompson of the same State and District and for the further consideration of paying all my individual debts and liabilities in preference to those which I may owe or be liable for as surety or partner of my brother General William Jones or any one else, have granted, bargained, sold, transferred and assigned over and by these presents do Grant, bargain, sell, transfer and assign over to General Waddy Thompson all my rights, title and interest in the estate of my late brother George Jones, deceased, either under the will of my father George Jones decd or as one of the heirs and representatives of my said brother George Jones decd.

To have and to hold all and singular all my interest above mentioned unto the said Waddy Thompson his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns for the following uses and purposes First the said General Waddy Thompson is to collect and receive the said interest either now or at the death of my Mother Mrs Elizabeth Jones as the case may be and pay over the same in equal discharge of all my individual debts as I have already provided for in deed executed to the said Waddy Thompson during last Spring Secondly after the payment of my individual debts, the said Waddy Thompson is to pay over the remainder if any to my creditors equally to whom I am liable as partner or surety of my brother William Jones or any one else, the said creditors to be paid equally in proportion to their demands
